Experimental

BENEFITS:

Skills

- Problem solving, critical thinking, decision-making skills, promotes creativity, teamwork, skills to make informed and responsible decisions, enhancing science education, improve academic performance, social skills – listening, creative activities – art, increases imagination

Health

- Reduced crime and aggression, reduced antisocial behavior, reduced symptoms of ADHD in children, improved psychological well-being, building confidence and efficacy, reducing risk taking behavior and promoting safe practice, reduces childhood obesity and the effects of asthma, link between the physical activity of 12-year-olds and their bone mineral density when they reach their early twenties

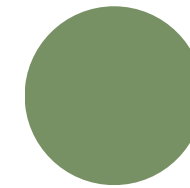


WATER OFFICE – ZONE FLOOR PLAN

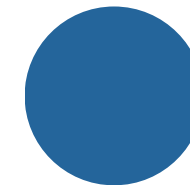




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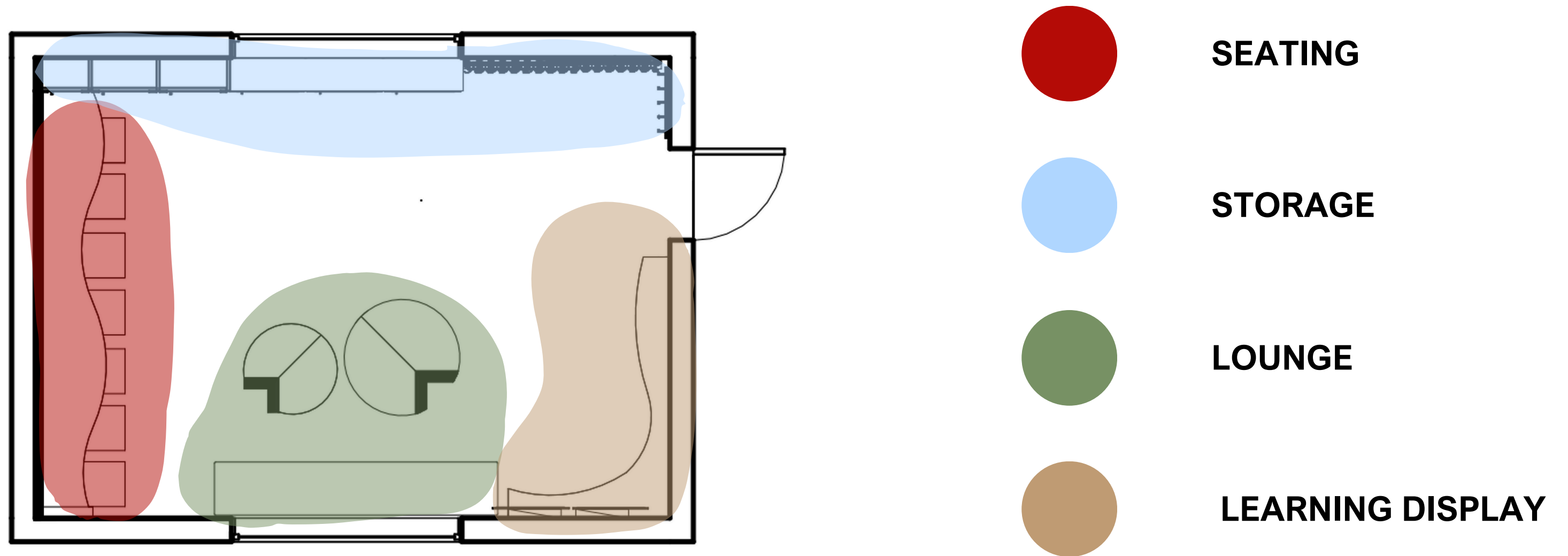


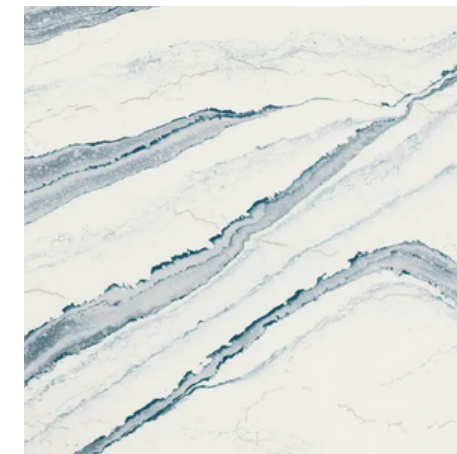
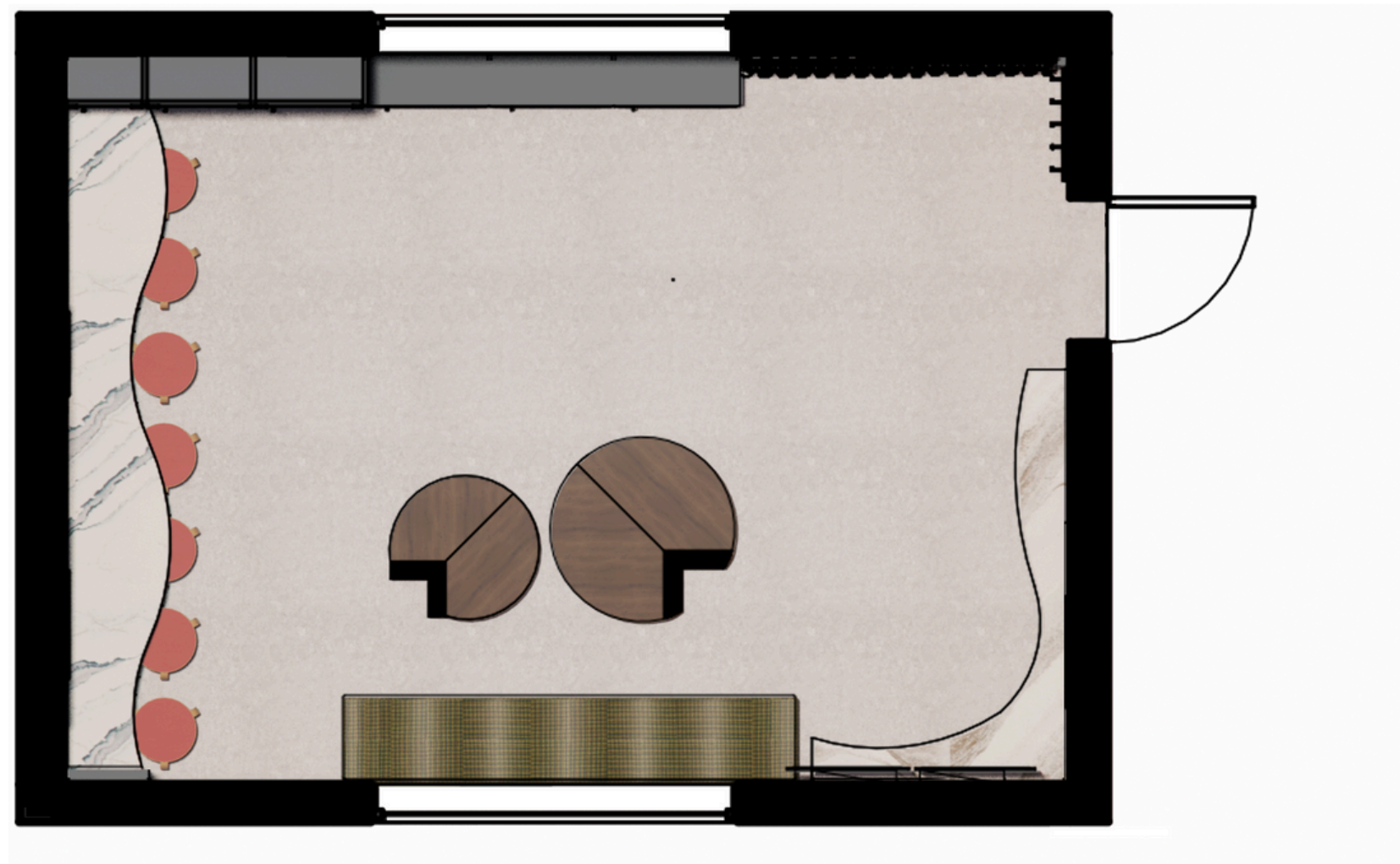


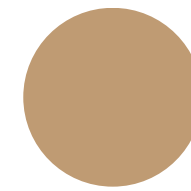
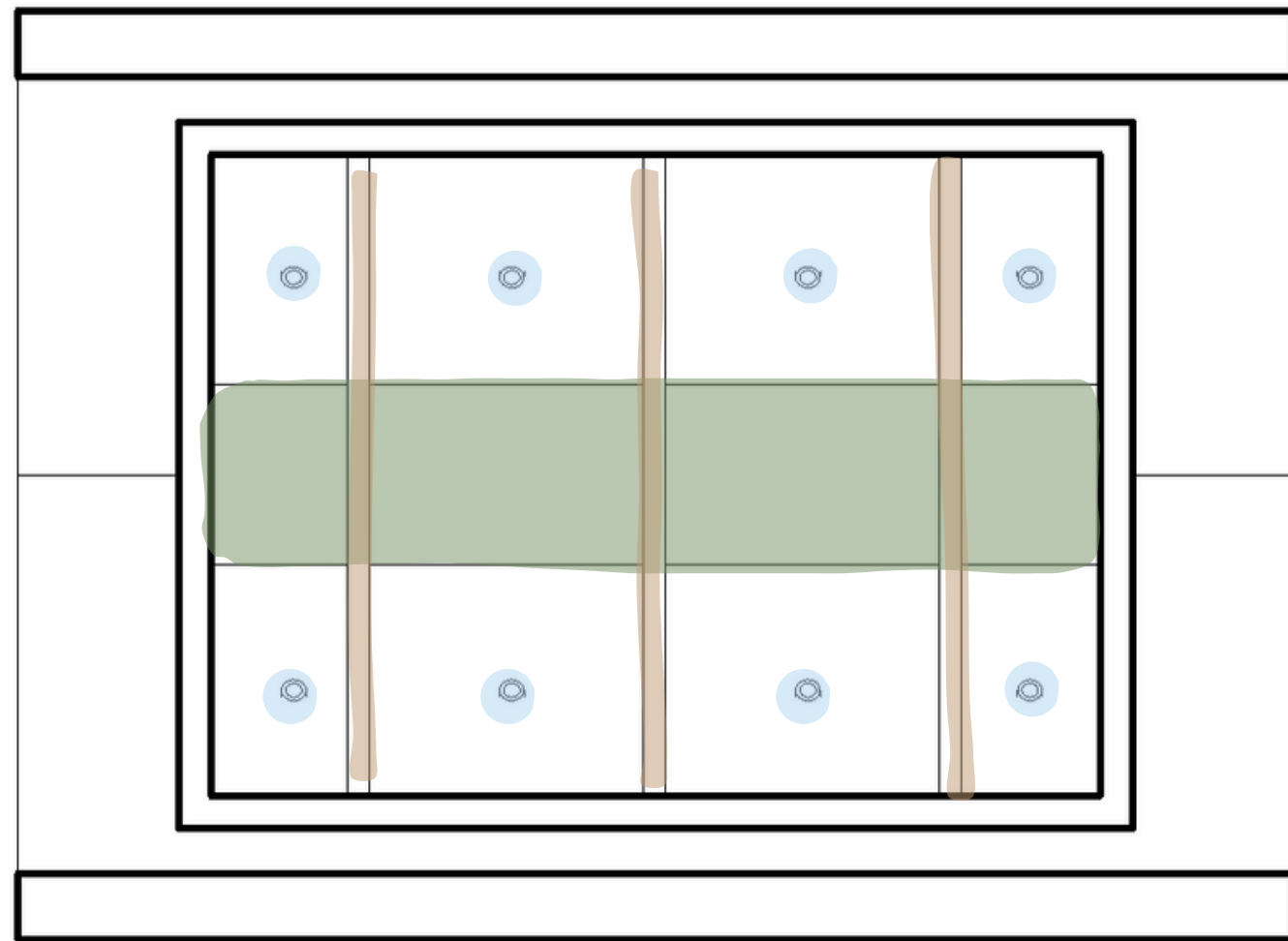
